

# What we can do...

- **Learn about what will be protected and where in the San Juan Islands by reviewing the Geographic Response Plan (GRP) for your shoreline.**
  1. Find your shoreline property and/or favorite shoreline places to visit on the GRP maps.
  2. If you find that the spill prevention and response capacity is not adequate (for a major oil spill including a spill of diluted bitumen, it is *not*)...
- **Contact our Governor and U.S. Coast Guard to ask for improved prevention and the equipment, personnel and training needed to clean up an oil spill and spills of diluted bitumen.**
- **Contact our State and Federal representatives about diluted bitumen.**
  1. Advocate for legislation that defines diluted bitumen as an oil, subject to oil spill regulations and crude oil taxes.
  2. Advocate for regulations that address the challenges of diluted bitumen spills; improve spills prevention and shipping safety; ensure the full payment for clean-up; and require the spill response equipment, personnel, and training needed to clean-up a major oil spill.
- **Join Islands' Oil Spill Association (IOSA) to help prepare for a spill and to get the training required to help respond in the event of a spill.**
- **Thank the San Juan County Council for commenting on the Kinder Morgan application and for prioritizing improved oil spill prevention, preparedness and response.**
- **Watch for drift cards (that simulate what would happen if a spill occurred), and report the locations where you find them.**
